He was Model in the GDR, studied stage-, scenery and production design, and directing at HFF Potsdam Babelsberg. He also studied at Thammasat University Thailand with a DAAD scholarship.

Marco Wilms made cinema release documentaries like COMRADE COUTURE, TAILOR MADE DREAMS, ART WAR and METAL POLITICS TAIWAN with broadcasters in Europe (ARTE, ZDF, MDR, ORF, SF, AVRO, YLE, France 5...) and North America.

Marco Wilms is currently teaching film at the Faculty of Mass Communication at Chiang Mai University and worldwide.
